This program meets or exceeds the requirements of NFPA 1021; Standard for Fire Officer 1 & 2 Professional Qualifications, 2003 edition, and an opportunity for State Certification from Maine Fire Training and Education will be made available.

**This is a college level course; up to 6 college credits can be obtained from Southern Maine Community College for successful completion. Students should expect college level reading assignments, homework assignments, quizzes and tests.**

Areas of study will include:

Introduction to Fire Officer, Communications Preparing for Promotion, Firefighters and Fire Officers, Safety & Risk Management, Evaluation & Discipline, Pre-Incident Planning, Budgeting, Managing Incidents, Fire Command Simulations, and Fire Cause Determination

**Tuition:** \$425 includes text and student manuals
